1. Call to Order and Welcome

a. Kathy called the meeting to order.

2. Approval of Agenda

4. PVA Program Update

- a. Grant Subcommittee Lisa will coordinate those interested in working on grant applications, including Lisa, Estela, Michelle Dirk, Carolyn F. and Jason B. from Music (who work on Music grants), Michelle and Adam Mailman. Thanks to Estela for providing advice and resources.
- b. Kathy advised that Jacqui would coordinate the Ultimate Arts & Entertainment Raffle. If prepared in time, raffle tickets will be sold at Dance Central beginning March 20. Jacqui will coordinate prizes. Pattie will send a communication to all parents soliciting raffle donations for

theatre tickets, restaurants, etc., and Joy will send a reminder about prize solicitation to the committee. Once prize value is known, the AGLC license can be applied for.

8. Public Relations Update

a. Loretta and Kathy will discuss additional opportunities to promote the program, such as inviting guests to the spring gala.

a. Patti is working on a PVA Handbook and supporting Michelle with new student applications. The CPVAF Charms license will not be renewed as it is not being used. Music will continue to use Charms.

f. Theatre Arts - Angela

- Theatre Arts students helped teachers with the new PVA applicants in January and welcomed grade 9s and their families. Grade 10s are working with Ms. Crimmins and guest artist Graham Percy through a CAAMP Residency on their Mask and Movement skills. Grade 11s are learning Improv Technique with Ms. LeBlanc. Grade 12s are collaborating with Ms. Goutsis and guest artist Christian Goutsis on their Acting Technique and On Camera acting skills. Rehearsals have kicked off for our spring play and musical. The play is Progress, with co-directors Ms. Crimmins and Geoffrey Simon Brown. The musical is The Prom, with Ms. Goutsis and guest instructors Alison Stone and Gavin Caldwell.
- For the first time, PVA Technical Theatre Program is offers classes within the daily schedule. After-school courses will continue, providing technical service to all productions and events. The new courses will be Intro I & II, Intermediate I & II, and Advanced I & II. Course credits will include CTS modules from construction, design, logistics, communications, electronic technology, and fashion. The new classes will allow students to deepen their knowledge and skills in specific technical areas while increasing the production quality of our shows.
